

What is the Family Hubs Network?



Family Hubs are where you can find support for you and your family, both in person and online. Support is available for all stages of family life, from pregnancy through to 19 years old or 25 for those with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND).

We work with a large network of local partners including NHS, district authorities, schools, libraries, the police and voluntary, community and faith-based organisations. Together, we work closely with children, young people and families to provide the information, advice and support they need in one place.

The Family Hub network is made up of Family Hubs, Family Centres and online support and access to services. Families can access a wide range of services at Family Hubs, such as Midwifery, Health, Infant feeding, Early help, SEND and Mental health support. There is also help with Finances, Employment, Education and Learning.

Many schools and services in Chorley already provide families with support and help. The Family Hubs Network wants to link organisations and services together so they can help with children, young people and families with any specific needs or issues.
